Taittinger is our house selected champagne. A light elegant champagne, dominated by chardonnay followed by meunier and pinot noir, it is aged for at least three years to give it a more mature, rounded character to balance the crisp apple flavour.

Taittinger Brut Prestige Rosé has delicious soft red fruit aromas with a touch of spice.

St Evremond was a French Field Marshall in the armies of Louis XIV until he was exiled to England. He brought the sparkling wines of Champagne with him as he settled into the court of Charles II. Very particular about the style of wine he liked, he is thought to have introduced Champagne to the royal court. Now owned by Taittinger the wine is a pinot dominated champagne with a low dosage of 8 grams of sugar per litre giving the wine a delicacy and slight sharpness that makes it an ideal aperitif.

OUR SIGNATURE COCKTAILS

Arkle Pimm's Cocktail £10.50
(Pimm's No 1 Cup, Tanqueray Gin, Cointreau, Fevertree Lemonade and Fevertree Ginger Ale)
Developed in the early 1800's to make the gins of the time more palatable, Pimm's No 1 Cup is a maceration of gin and various fruits and liqueurs developed by oyster bar owner James Pimm. Now a classic summer cocktail enjoyed the world over with many variations on the recipe. This is our little take on a classic.

Cosmopolitan £10.50
(Belvedere Vodka, Grand Marnier, Cranberry Juice, fresh Lime Juice, Sugar)
A relatively new cocktail whose origins are somewhat disputed. Cheryl Cook is generally credited with its invention in the early 1980's in South Beach, Miami. The drink spread fast throughout the USA and gained popularity in the 1990's after being mentioned frequently in the television series Sex and the City.

Margarita £10.50
(Jose Cuervo Gold Tequila, Cointreau, Fresh Lime Juice)
The Margarita is one of the most enduring cocktails of the last century. Supposedly the drink was created for Margarita Sames, an American socialite of the 1940's, who liked to serve it at her parties in Acapulco, although some references to the drink can be found a decade or so earlier. Whoever came up with the drink, it was certainly the first cocktail made from Tequila.

Daiquiri £10.50
(10 Cane Rum, Fresh Lime Juice, Gomme Syrup)
The simple blend of rum, fresh lime juice and sugar was reputedly invented around 1905 by an American mining engineer named Jennings Cox, who was working at an iron mine in the town of Daiquiri on the southeast coast of Cuba. Legend has it that Cox came up with the idea when he ran out of gin while entertaining guests, but it's likely that this combo was already being drunk in Cuba, since the island produces limes, sugar cane and rum in abundance.

New Yorker £10.50
(Bulleit Bourbon, Grenadine, Fresh Orange Juice)
A slight adaption of an old classic. We've substituted orange juice for the lime juice to give a touch of extra sweetness and bite to the drink. A sublime drink to start the evening, tailored to titillate the taste buds, the New Yorker is as sophisticated and classy as the town from which it derives its name.

SIGNATURE COCKTAILS CONT...

Springtime Cooler £10.50
(Tanqueray Gin, Cheshire Apple Juice, Cassis and Fresh Mint)

We've taken delicious, locally produced Eddisbury Fruit Farm apple juice and poured it over a large slug of gin muddled with fresh mint. Topped up with crushed ice, a dash of Chase Farms Cassis Liqueur is poured over the top to create this lovely refreshing drink, perfect for the warmer months.

Citrus Caipirovska £10.50
(Belvedere Cytrus and Pomaranicza Vodka, Fresh Lime juice, Gomme Syrup, Orange Bitters)

A delightful Russian inspired take on the famous South American cocktail. The addition of Belvedere Cytrus and Pomaranicza vodkas creates an extra dimension to the flavours providing a tantalizing taste of summer.

Bloody Mary £10.50
(Belvedere Vodka, Tomato Juice, Worcester sauce, Tabasco and Chilli)

The Bloody Mary is believed to have been created by George Jessel around 1939. A gossip column in the New York Herald printed what is believed to be the first reference to this drink, along with the original recipe: "George Jessel's newest pick-me-up which is receiving attention from the town's paragraphers is called a Bloody Mary: half tomato juice, half vodka."

Tom Collins £10.50
(Tanqueray Gin, Fresh Lemon Juice, Soda, Gomme Syrup)

Tales of the naming of the Tom Collins vary as widely as the recipes, though there are two basic varieties. Some believe that it was named after the alcohol used in its mixing, Old Tom Gin. Others believe it was named after the clever bartender who invented it. The mysteries surrounding the spawning of the Tom Collins suggest one conclusion; a Tom Collins is for drinking, not studying.

Arkle Mule £10.50
(Belvedere Vodka, Bundaberg Ginger Beer, Lime Juice, Angostura Bitters)

The Mule kicked off the vodka craze in the United States during the 1950s. They say it's called a mule because the drink has a mighty kick to it. By using Ginger Beer instead of Ginger Ale, we've added more bite to it. A long and refreshingly spicy drink.
